### Arrive

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- Check-in to your interview early, but no more than 15 minutes early
- Bring a copy of your resume for your interviewer
- Eliminate distractions by turning off your phone or leaving it out of site

### Engage

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- Speak clearly and look your interviewer in the eye when they are speaking
- Talk about your experiences confidently and be yourself
- Prepare questions to ask your interviewer
